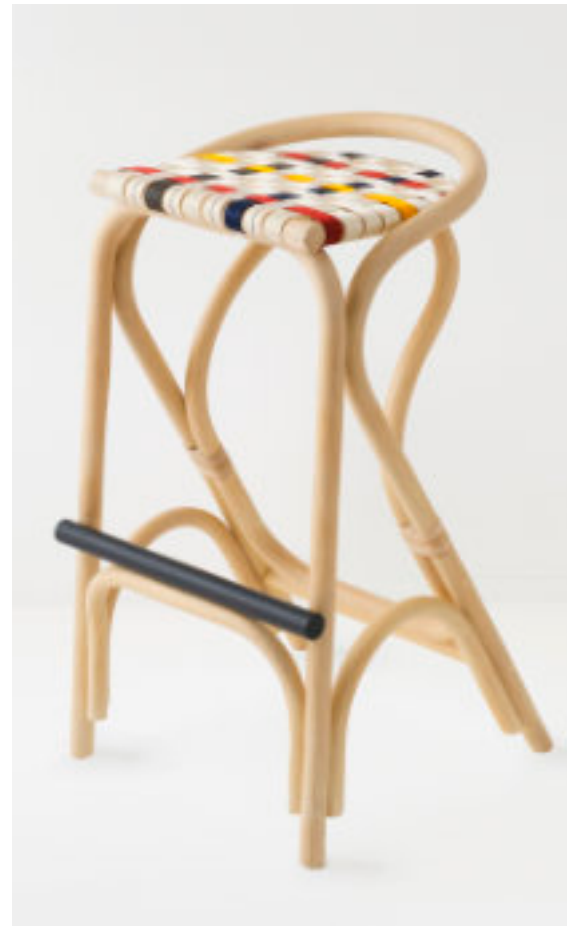
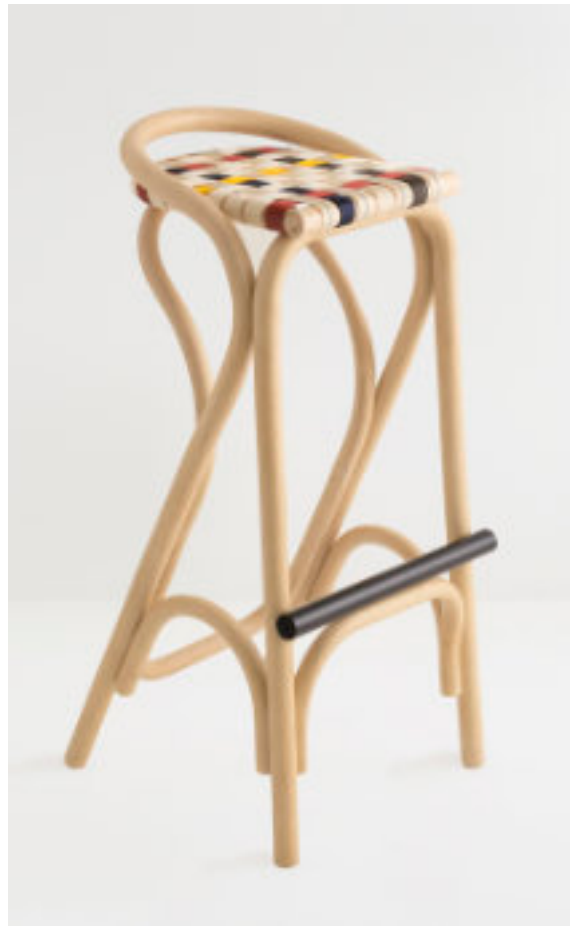

Jean-Michel Policar



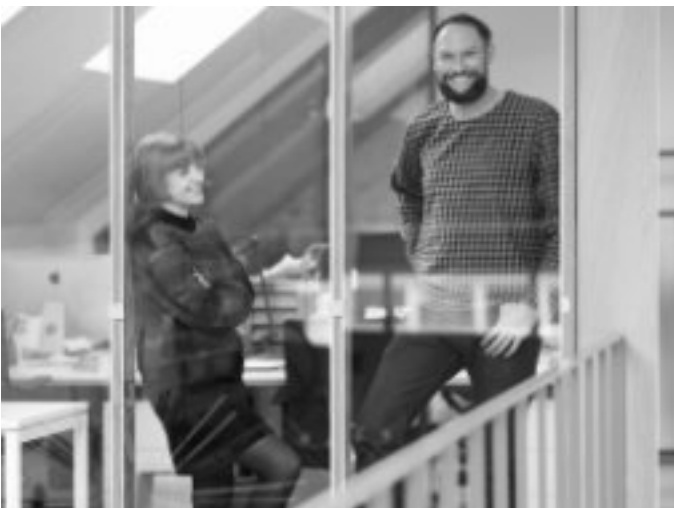

He inaugurated his first solo exhibition at the Tools Galerie and won the Grand Prix de la Création de la Ville de Paris

Studio AC/AL



Graduates of École Nationale Supérieure de Création Industrielle, Amandine Chhor and Aïssa Logerot began their careers working for various architectural and design agencies. They founded the AC/AL studio in 2013 with the aim of designing projects that tell a story and reflect a correctness between function, form and production techniques.



ORCHID EDITION PROJECT

Orchid Edition is first and foremost a family story : initiated by the Ledi family which for four generations has invested in the history of rattan through the manufacturing company Kok Maison. Orchid Edition was born out of the desire of its founder, Tina Ledi, to give new life to the rattan furniture, to revisit it in order to propose a contemporary and timeless version.

It partners with today's designers to create a collection of high-end furniture that highlights the qualities of this noble material. Along with her daughter Marion, Tina Ledi created Orchid Edition, illustrating the idea of transmission and family tradition.

It took two years of research before Orchid Edition was born. Two years to reinvent, reinterpret traditional gestures from contemporary drawings. This editor proposes a sophisticated and elegant universe, aiming to emphasize the qualities and aesthetics of the rattan cane. It mixes in a balanced way: heritage, by the use of traditional webbing and modernity, thanks to the combination of technical materials such as metal or polyester strap.

Tina Ledi chose to launch models that look like her. Originally from the Netherlands, she was brought up in France and has been influenced by her international experiences and has a passion for Asia. The name of Orchid Edition seemed obvious : the qualities of this exotic flower are what defines, according to her, an international and timeless design : elegance, discretion, sobriety but also warmth, femininity and sensuality.

Orchid Edition collections are designed for indoor use. The rattan frames are produced in Indonesia, cushions and straps are made in France.

Each piece of furniture is unique and highlights the natural color of rattan, protected by a matt varnish.



RATTAN, AN UNKNOWN NATURAL MATERIAL, MAGNIFIED BY ORCHID EDITION

Rattan is a solid wood with a fibrous core that grows in the tropical forests of Southeast Asia. Each piece of furniture is made in Indonesia according to the techniques and the ancestral know-how of master workers. Promoting the expertise of these craftsmen is an integral part of Orchid Edition's commitments.

The high-end positioning of the brand goes hand in hand with its environmental commitment : going against mass manufacturing, often devastating forests and harmful to the ecosystem, the desire to create in small series, to save material without ever throwing anything away and to manufacture sustainable models designed to be transmitted.
